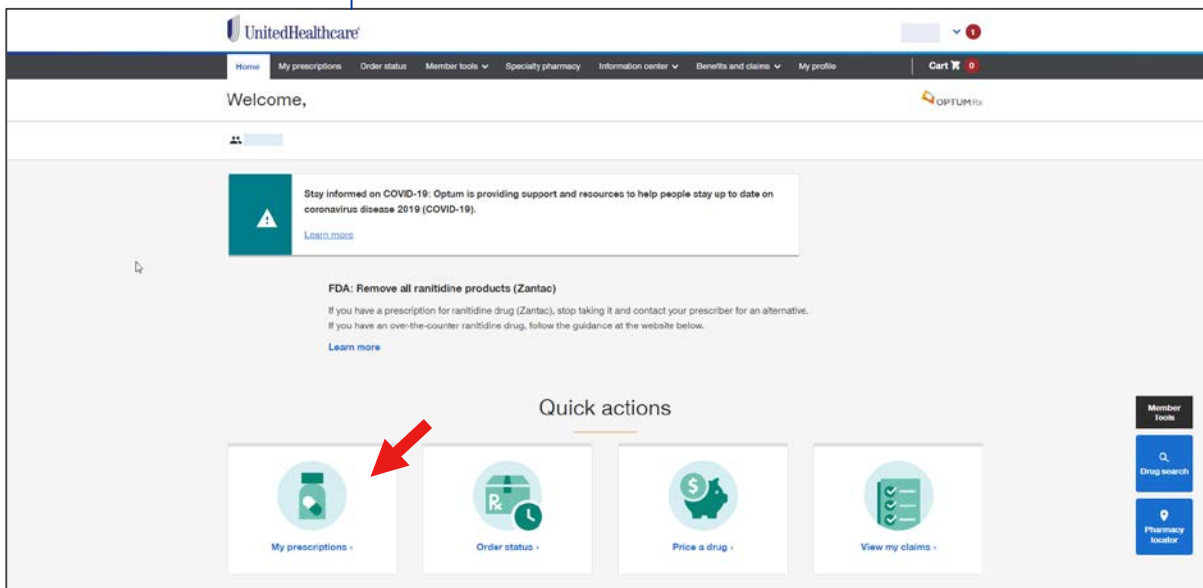
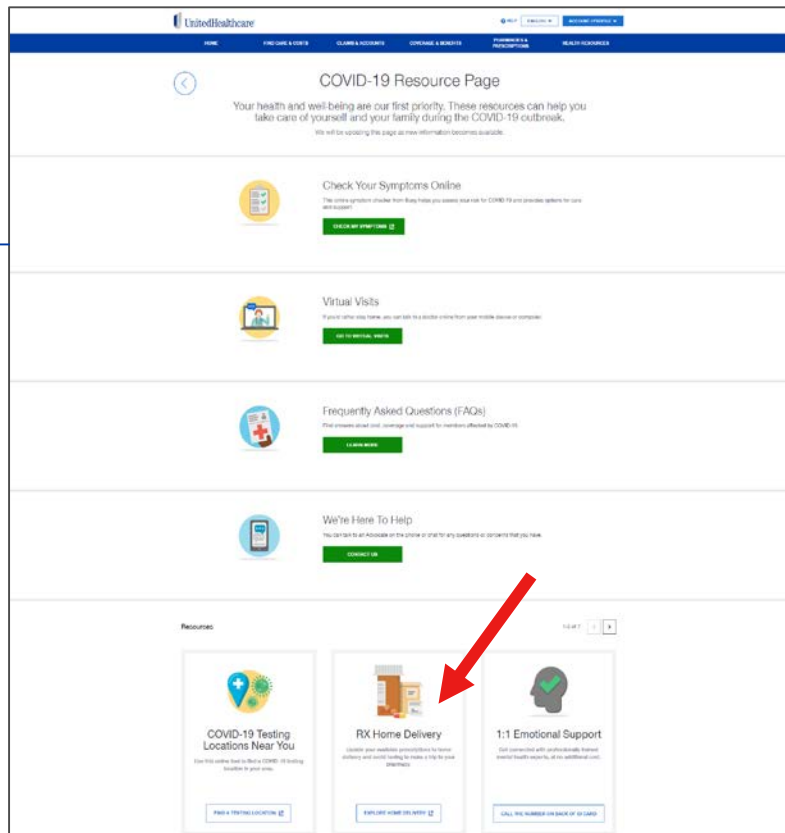


COVID-19: Simplified process to enroll in home delivery

The quick link on the COVID-19 resources page is another way for members to quickly enroll in home delivery.

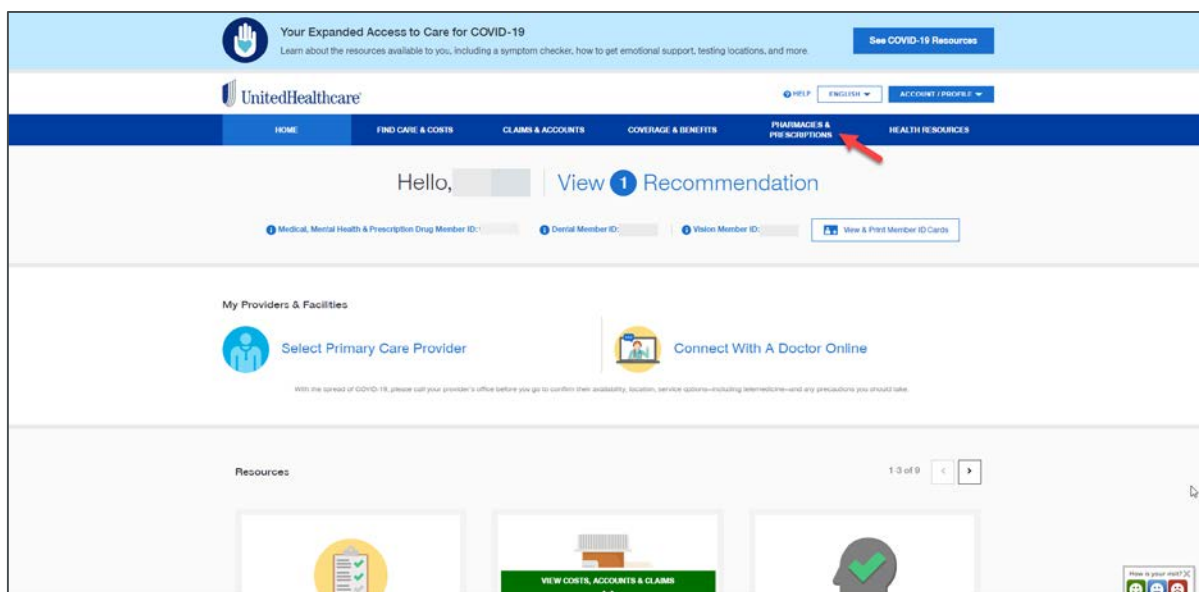
The link on the COVID-19 resources page will direct members to the dashboard.



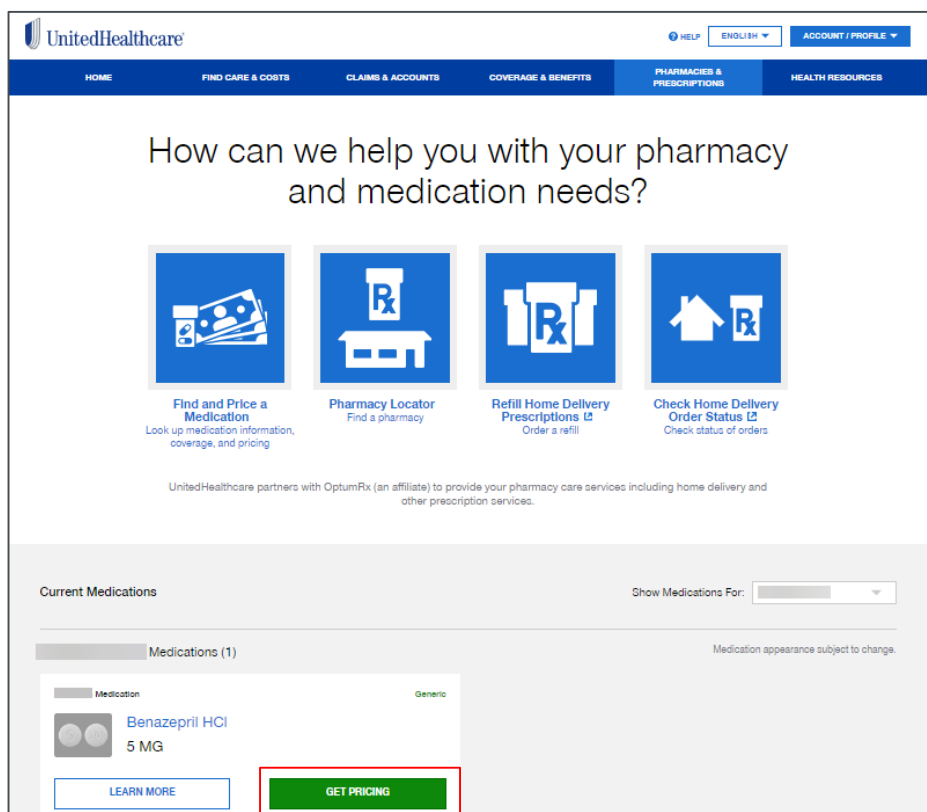
Transferring retail prescriptions is simple.
